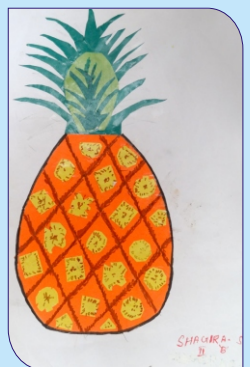
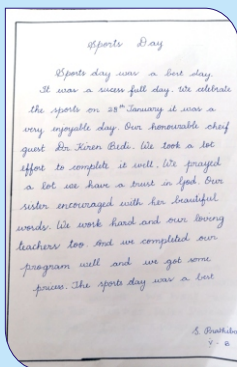
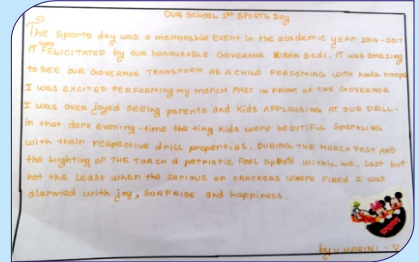

Bayabas/Guava (*Psidium guajava* L.)

- **Uses & Preparation:**
 - For washing wounds** - Maybe use twice a day
 - Diarrhea** - May be taken 3-4 times a day
 - As gargle and for toothache** - Warm decoction is used for gargle. Freshly pounded leaves are used for toothache. Boil chopped leaves for 15 minutes at low fire. Do not cover and then let it cool and strain
